



Memorial Weekend Tournament Rules

The following is a summary of the rules which will be enforced during tournament play. Nebraska Select Basketball is trying to make this tournament as close to what we will see this summer. We want players to get the feel of being on a traveling team and see how the summer games are being played. The changes we are seeing are 16-minute halves, players receiving 6 fouls, and a total of 3 timeouts per game.

A. All games will start on time. Teams should be ready to play at the scheduled times. Any team not ready to play within five minutes of a scheduled game time will forfeit that game.

B. Each game shall be made up of two 16-minute halves. The time clock will run for the first 13 minutes and then be stopped on all dead balls during the last 3 minutes of each half.

C. Each team will have 3 time-outs per game. 1 time-out in overtime with no carryover from regulation.

D. 20 Point Mercy Rule: If a team is ahead by 20 or more points when the clock hits 2 min of the 2nd half, a mercy rule will apply and the game will be over.

E. Each half time will last three minutes.

F. One and one free throws will be shot after the seventh foul. There will be no double bonus shot when ten team fouls are reached. Each player will be allowed 6 fouls.

G. Each team can have a minimum of 7 players.

H. Current National Federation of High School Interscholastic Basketball Rules shall apply. What that means is we are playing a regular basketball game with the exception of rule B half's instead of quarters along with different timeouts, rule E where 6 fouls are given to each player and rule H with different overtime rules.

I. Overtime will result in a sudden death. First team to score a point wins. Overtime will start with a jump ball.

J. All games officiated by NSAA certified officials.

K. During tournament play, the bench area will be restricted to players and designated coaches.

L. Players and coaches shall conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner.

M. All decisions of the tournament director with respect to the rules shall be final.

N. All players and coaches are to remain off the main floor until their warm-up time begins. Coaches need to have their players pick up all items after their game (water and Gatorade bottles, tape, and personal belongings).

O. PLEASE READ! EACH TEAM WILL BE REQUIRED TO FURNISH A SCOREKEEPER. PLEASE GET A KNOWLEDGEABLE PARENT OR COACH TO DO THIS AS HE OR SHE WILL RECEIVE A FREE PASS FOR THE ENTIRE WEEKEND.

P. A qualified trainer will be available on-site for the entire weekend. If a player needs to be taped up before his game please make timely arrangements with our trainer. Also, the player will need to furnish his own tape or there will be a \$2 charge per ankle. Please be advised.
